Mimi Apple provided this month's **safety message**, which is no accident. PFDs (personal flotation device) are a sailor's best friend. She noted what we all currently wear are correct (Type 3 vests), because we are required to wear them! It was noted, there are some

changes in the new PFDs out there. The Coast Guard will still approve them, but they will be in just one type. Matt Miller is a Hobie Cat representative who provided information and news about PFDs in the most current Hotline issue. Zhik brand jackets good jackets, but are not up to the necessary qualifications. There will in the future just one type, so it will be easier to buy one without questions. She suggests going to **Boat Works** in E. Syracuse to purchase one, buy local, and to make sure you have the right size. You don't want one too big, as it could come loose

Other Business:


- Chalk talks are popular, but there was discussion to hold them at a
