Commodore's Corner



Fleet 204 Meeting Minutes May 12, 2015

The meeting was called to order by **Vice Commodore Bob Longo** at 8:00pm at Borio's Restaurant. There were about 22 Fleet members in attendance. He welcomed everyone to the meeting. **Commodore Straigis** apologized that she could not make the meeting due to a work commitment.

Safety Talk, Mimi Appel, Title: Safety Priorities, the Big Picture. Can someone be severely hurt



while sailing? Of course, the answer is *yes*. US sailing mandates and requires certain procedures to ensure safety. Fleet 204 has been relatively safe for 39 years, without any major accidents or incidents. Lightning struck near a Fleet member and other minor incidents have happened, though. We cannot let our guard down. We need to be very aware major accidents can happen. Big wind can happen quickly; just look at what happened a recent regatta on the Gulf Coast (Dauphin Island Regatta, May, 2015 -

http://www.al.com/news/mobile/index.ssf/2015/05/a cruel wind how the 2015 daup.html). Oneida Lake can stir up very fast. As the summer progresses, it would be good to have a safety plan. We need to make sure we practice good habits, such as telling someone you are going out sailing (especially when you are singlehanded), and always wearing your PFD. Tell someone when you expect to be off the water. Use your cell phones to look at radar before you go out, and get a good weather app. We'd like to create a simple check list of items and concepts to review at least twice a year. Keep the 204 attitude of safety and keep the big picture in mind and be serious, help keep an eye on each other.



Secretary's Report: Bruce Krupke reported that the May 2015 minutes were put into the Fleet newsletter by Editor Theresa White and Publisher Adam Atherton. There weren't any changes or additions. There was a motion to accept the minutes, seconded and passed.



Treasurer's Report: Dr. Bill Whalen noted the checking accounts are about the same as last month in our 2 accounts, looking good. Madcatter budget are expected to be about even. A final tally will be reported at the next meeting. Fleet Youths Val Wiehl and Erica Longo would like to attend the national event in



Washington State in July. (Hobie Youth Hobie 16 North Americans in Lake Quinault, Quinault, Washington, July 26 – 29, 2015). They have applied for a grant to help with the expenses for travel. They have asked for 204 financial sponsorship support. There was a motion to assist the team of up to \$500. The amount will be added to whatever shortfall they can't raise or get from a grant HCA. There was discussion about how to support our youth, the future of the sport and



Fleet. There was discussion regarding help in finding sponsors and assisting in training them and whether this is setting precedent for future teams. It was agreed we should support youths and each year consider doing what we can. There was a motion to provide up to \$500 in financial support after they have determined what support they will get from HCA. There was a second to the motion, and the vote carried. The Youths thanked the Fleet for their support and will do us proud at the Nationals.

 Planning for Madcatter 40 is starting. GEP budget was discussed we need to start early to find one. We need to start and solidify many details earlier than normal. We need to find more housing for volunteers, talk it up. If you want to be on the planning committee for the

40th, talk, to the Commodore or VC Bob Longo. We need to have a good plan and the earlier the better. MC 40 planning discussion. There was discussion about using the Arrowhead Lodge for the 40th, and or the Tent. There was support for both the Lodge and tent. There are pros and cons to both locations. Jan. 1 until the decision needs to be made to actually use it or not.


- See the racing schedule; you can participate in a regatta just about every weekend.

- There was discussion about creating a new Hall of Fame board. Sue Korz will look into the costs. \$200 was suggested for a new one. She'll get a quote on it. There was a motion and a second to the idea, vote carried.
- Fleet boats were discussed. We are currently using Tom
 Byrne's boat. Bob Longo is getting the Winner boat fixed; it





has a bad line, and might cost around \$200. We can park one boat at a time at Caster's. The pontoon boat is being looked at, parts, tank, battery, seats are in the warehouse. 
